




What do we do in Third Grade AAP?

Level IV Center & Local Level IV Comparison

AAP <u>Level IV Center</u> Programs

- Students are grouped only with students who have been found eligible for full-time services through the central selection process
- Students from multiple feeder schools leave base schools to attend a center site

- AAP curriculum is used full-time in all four content areas
- Classroom teachers have (or are working towards) AAP endorsement
- Schools receive continuous professional learning

AAP <u>Local Level IV</u> Programs

- Schools use cluster grouping models to ensure an academic peer group for students identified for level IV AAP
- Additional students are grouped in the class
- Curriculum access is expanded to more students with scaffolding for support
- Serves only students from neighborhood school (students do not need to leave their base school)

A Note About Homework

- Local full-time AAP (local level IV) and Center-based AAP follow the same policy outlined in the <u>FCPS homework guideline</u>.
- Full-Time AAP services do not entail "more" homework than typical grade level guidelines.
